The percentage of the senior citizens in India's population has been growing at an alarming rate and ageing will emerge as major social change in the future and vast resources will be required towards the Support, Services, Care and Treatment of the elderly persons.

As per report of United Nations Population Fund the population of elderly people in India is expected to go to 20% in 2050 and will be nearly 50crs. The rapid increase in the population of senior citizens has increased physical, social and emotional problems of elder persons. The major challenge therefore is to ensure that not only the senior citizen live longer but lead a secure dignified and productive life. Most of the senior citizens are fighting isolation, neglect, poverty and loss of dignity. Ageing has become a major social issue. It is necessary to provide economic and health needs to elderly and to create a society, which is sensitive to their emotional needs.

Community living for the Senior Citizens found to be the best solution, which will greatly reduce the problem of their dependency and isolation. As a result, "**Aastha Foundation Aurangabad**" NGO was established with "**Joyful Old Age**" as the conceptual vision and objective and registered under societies and trust act in 2008. In particular, it is working for the betterment of senior citizens to provide them Comfort and Care, Love, Dignity and Respect.

Basant Prabha Visava – A Dream Project

"To construct an "Elder Care Home" as a "Long Term Residential Facility for Sr. Citizens including assisted living is **MISSION** of the trust.". This building will not be just a structure of bricks and cement but will be an epitome of elder care which will cater to needs for generations to come.

One of the trustees, Shri Sunil Agrawal in the memory of his father, gifted 3 acre land to Aastha Foundation. Out of planned 25000 sq.ft., 14700 sq.ft construction is completed in first phase and full pledge functioning started from 22/1/2023. The salient features of this project are:

1. 3 acre charming natural environment, surrounded with big trees, calm, secured premises

2. Beautiful, airy, spacious, comfortable rooms having attached wash rooms with handles and railings wherever required.
3. All facilities required for old age are taken care of.
4. Health care, Physical and emotional assistance, hygienic food, planned kitchen
5. A team of trained geriatric caregivers round the clock is provided to take care of all residents including dementia patients.
6. All amenities like Garden, Walking track, Miyawaki forest, Library, Entertainment zone, Meditation hall, Counseling Physiotherapy etc. provided.
7. Doctors visit two times a week and ambulance service is available in case of emergency.
8. Residents are also allowed for short period and rehabilitation of operated patients for physiotherapy as per advice is available.
9. Opportunity to live remaining life as Golden Years of Life.

Certificate Course in Geriatric Care:

Aastha has recognized the need of trained caregivers for Sr. Citizens and since 2015, conducting the Geriatric Care course to create a team of the trained caregivers for old age people. This certificate course is being conducted in association Savitribai Phule Mahila Ekam Samaj Mandal as Implementing Partner. The course is conducted at Dr. Hedgewar Rugnalaya by renowned and experience doctors. Duration of course is 4 months with 3 months practical. Visit to other Old Age home for study and experience. The course is free of cost to the students even if the expenses per batch are to the tune of Rs.2.50 lakhs. The expenses are managed through donations. Till date 11 batches are conducted and team of 140 trained caregivers are providing service to the old age people.

Day Care Centre: A unique activity started in 2018, run by Trained Caregivers and Volunteers to give respite to family caregivers and dementia patients. Each patient is attended by one caregiver appointed by the trust.

Due to covid19 it was to be closed in 2020. It is restarted from 01/04/23.

Aastha foundation Aurangabad is taking rigorous efforts in the area of dementia, which is common in old age.

Activities include creating awareness in people, its diagnosis, care & precautions and even conducting training for the caregivers of dementia patient. Aastha is arranging at least one public program for awareness of the dementia disease.

In addition to this we are conducting weekly a **Memory Clinic** during 16.00hrs to 18.00hrs, at **“Basant Prabha Visava”** in which prominent doctors', Psychotherapist, Psychiatric are invited to take session on memory, oblivion, serious oblivion and dementia. Till date more than 150 experts delivered speech on various subjects like memory, health, psychology, philosophy, entertainment, solving puzzles etc.
